- 1 Section 1. Section 265.01 of the penal law is amended by adding a new
- 2 subdivision 9 to read as follows:
- 3 (9) A person is guilty of criminal possession of a weapon in the
- 4 fourth degree when, with knowledge of the character thereof, he
- 5 possesses a trigger crank, a bump-fire device, or any part, combination
- 6 of parts, component, device, attachment, or accessory which is designed
- 7 or functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semi-automatic rifle in
- 8 such a way so as to approximate the operation of a machine-gun.
- 9 § 2. Subdivisions 1 and 2 of section 265.10 of the penal law, as
- 10 amended by chapter 257 of the laws of 2008, are amended to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 1. Any person who manufactures or causes to be manufactured any
- 13 machine-gun, assault weapon, large capacity ammunition feeding device or
- 14 disguised gun is guilty of a class D felony. Any person who manufactures
- or causes to be manufactured a trigger crank, a bump-fire device, or any
- 16 part, combination of parts, component, device, attachment, or accessory
- 17 which is designed or functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semi-
- 18 automatic rifle in such a way so as to approximate the operation of a
- 19 machine-gun is guilty of a class E felony. Any person who manufactures
- 20 or causes to be manufactured any switchblade knife, gravity knife, pilum
- 21 ballistic knife, metal knuckle knife, billy, blackjack, bludgeon, plas-
- 22 tic knuckles, metal knuckles, Kung Fu star, chuka stick, sandbag, sand-
- 23 club or slungshot is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 2. Any person who transports or ships any machine-gun, firearm silenc-
- 25 er, assault weapon or large capacity ammunition feeding device or
- 26 disguised gun, or who transports or ships as merchandise five or more
- 27 firearms, is guilty of a class D felony. Any person who transports or
- 28 ships a trigger crank, a bump-fire device, or any part, combination of

- 1 parts, component, device, attachment, or accessory which is designed or
- 2 functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semi-automatic rifle in
- 3 such a way so as to approximate the operation of a machine-gun is guilty
- 4 of a class E felony. Any person who transports or ships as merchandise
- 5 any firearm, other than an assault weapon, switchblade knife, gravity
- 6 knife, pilum ballistic knife, billy, blackjack, bludgeon, plastic knuck-
- 7 les, metal knuckles, Kung Fu star, chuka stick, sandbag or slungshot is
- 8 guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 9 § 3. Subdivision 3 of section 897 of the general business law is
- 10 renumbered subdivision 4 and a new subdivision 3 is added to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 3. No trigger crank, a bump-fire device, or any part, combination of
- 13 parts, component, device, attachment, or accessory which is designed or
- 14 functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semi-automatic rifle in
- 15 such a way so as to approximate the operation of a machine-gun shall be
- 16 sold in this state to any person, firm, association or corporation
- 17 except that nothing in this section shall be construed to forbid the
- 18 sale of such goods to the state or any political subdivision thereof for
- 19 <u>a law enforcement agency.</u>
- 20 § 4. Subdivision 6 of section 898 of the general business law is
- 21 renumbered subdivision 7 and a new subdivision 6 is added to read as
- 22 follows:
- 23 <u>6. No trigger crank, a bump-fire device, or any part, combination of</u>
- 24 parts, component, device, attachment, or accessory which is designed or
- 25 functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semi-automatic rifle in
- 26 <u>such a way so as to approximate the operation of a machine-gun shall be</u>
- 27 sold in this state to any person, firm, association or corporation
- 28 except that nothing in this section shall be construed to forbid the

- 1 sale of such goods to the state or any political subdivision thereof for
- 2 a law enforcement agency.
- 3 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that
- 4 section one of this act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth
- 5 day after it shall have become a law.
